High gasoline prices have set a record of dubious distinction. On Tuesday the national average price for a gallon of regular gasoline topped \$3 per gallon for the 1,000th consecutive day for the first time on record.



AAA forecasts that the national average will remain above \$3 per gallon for at least another 1,000 days, barring a major economic recession.

Paying less than \$3 a gallon could be as much an automotive history as going to a drive-in movie, AAA said. The streak began Dec. 23, 2010. Last year fuel was the most expensive year on record, with gasoline averaging \$3.60 a gallon, AAA said.

The statewide average in Missouri is \$3.339. The national average is just over \$3.51/gallon
