Grundy County Farm Bureau had the Best Organizational float, Preferred Family had the Best Business float, a Grundy R-5 FFA float was the the Best Overall Youth entry, Salem Baptist had the Best Religious entry, Quentin Brown of Trenton had the Best Car or Truck Pre 1960 with a 1946 Chevy truck, Jeff Eads had the Best Car or Truck Post 1960 with a 2007 Corvette.

Tractor judging included Larry Holder of Chillicothe Winning Best of Show, Mike Eckert of Jamesport had the Oldest Tractor in the show, Bryce Walker of Chillicothe the Best Restored Tractor, and Neil Peery of Trenton had the Best Original Tractor.

Mike Williams of Humphreys received the award for Best Piece of Farm MachineryâOldest or Restored.

The tractor traveling the greatest distance was entered by Ron VanWinkle of Woodburn, Iowa.
