Mercer County Extension is offering information about the new health care law that an organizer says is designed to help families, individuals and businesses understand their options and responsibilities.



An informational program is scheduled next week in Princeton. On Thursday, December 12th, University Extension will host a program beginning at 6:30 that night in the Hal England building at 801 Hickland in Princeton. The event is part of MU Extension's Health Insurance Education Initiative designed to inform citizens on what the new law means for their families, businesses and the community.
