An Independence company will be laying underground fiber optics cable in southern Trenton for the next several days. It is part of work that covers a large area of northwest and north central Missouri. The route in Trenton, from west to east, involves portions of Highway 6, Fourth Street, Washington, 7th, Monroe, 8th, Olive, 9th Street (in the railroad area), Harris, 8th Street again, Kerfood, and Highway 6 (again). The projects involves a large area of EIGHTH Street.
