

**Come enjoy the fall festival in downtown Trenton Saturday**

What organizers are calling the "downtown fall festival" will be featured in Trenton Saturday afternoon and evening. The Trenton Downtown Improvement Association is sponsoring various activities from 2 o'clock until 7 o'clock.

The location is at, or near, Sesquicentennial Park. Several vendors are expected to set up with crafts and food items. There's a children parade at 2 o'clock Saturday. Wheel barrow races are planned at 5 o'clock on Main Street. Entertainment is planned beginning at 2 o'clock from the gazebo in the park. The performers in order are Judy Hanson, Chelsea Woodard, Laurie Franklin and Jenny; Melinda Hogan; Mandi and Jeremy Ripple; and concluding with the North 65 line dancers. A spokesperson for Citizen's Bank and Trust said the movie is "Big Miracle."

It's described as a family movie about a whale. Persons attending are asked to take a lawn chair or a blanket to sit on. There's no charge to view the entertainment or movie. As a fund-raiser for the association, tickets are sold in a raffle for prizes donated by merchants. (To clarify the drawing is actually Sunday of Missouri Day Festival) Proceeds go to beautification projects downtown including purchase of trash cans. A campaign also is forthcoming on the purchase of additional memorial benches for downtown locations.
