The North Central Missouri College Lady Pirates basketball team has signed its first recruit for the 2013-14 season. Kayla Oetterer, a 5'11" forward from New Haven, Missouri has made the decision to continue her basketball career at NCMC.

Oetterer is a 2012 graduate of New Haven High School and received a unanimous nomination to the Missouri Sports Writers and Broadcasters Association's All District First Team in 2012. Her other honors include Academic All-Conference 2011-12, All South Callaway Tournament Team 2011 and 2012, First Team All Conference 2010, 2011, and 2012, First Team All District 2011-12, KLPW Player of the Week 2011, and Prep Cast Player of the Game (Districts 2010). Oetterer's career point total is 1,358 with game averages of 12 points and 10 rebounds.
