

Gooseberry Festival Set For June 14, 15 And 16

The tenth annual Gooseberry Festival is set to be held at Trenton the third week in June, with a variety of events scheduled during the three day festival.



Friday June 14th, kicks off the festival with the Iowa-Missouri sanctioned truck and tractor pull start time is 7 in the evening. Admission to the event is \$10.00 for adults, children ten and under are admitted free with a paid adult admission. A special admission price of \$5.00 has been set for all military veterans, as well as active service members, law enforcement and emergency services personnel.

The event is slated for the North Central Missouri Fairgrounds, and includes pulling classes in pro street two wheel drive trucks, classic modified tractors, super field tractors, pro stock 4x4 trucks, hot farm tractors, pro field tractors and limited pro stock tractors.

Saturday, June 15th marks a variety of family events for the tenth annual Gooseberry festival.
