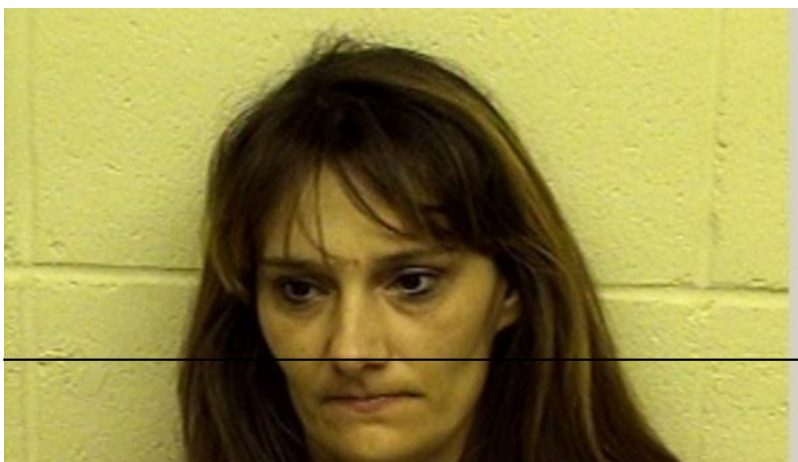


Lacey L. Stith, 27, Chillicothe, Distribution of a Controlled Substance, bond set at \$25,000 cash.
